Introduction

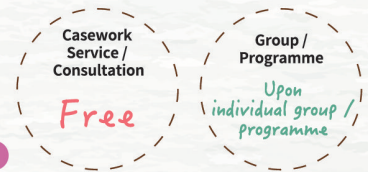
Hong Kong Children & Youth Services is a multi-social service agency.

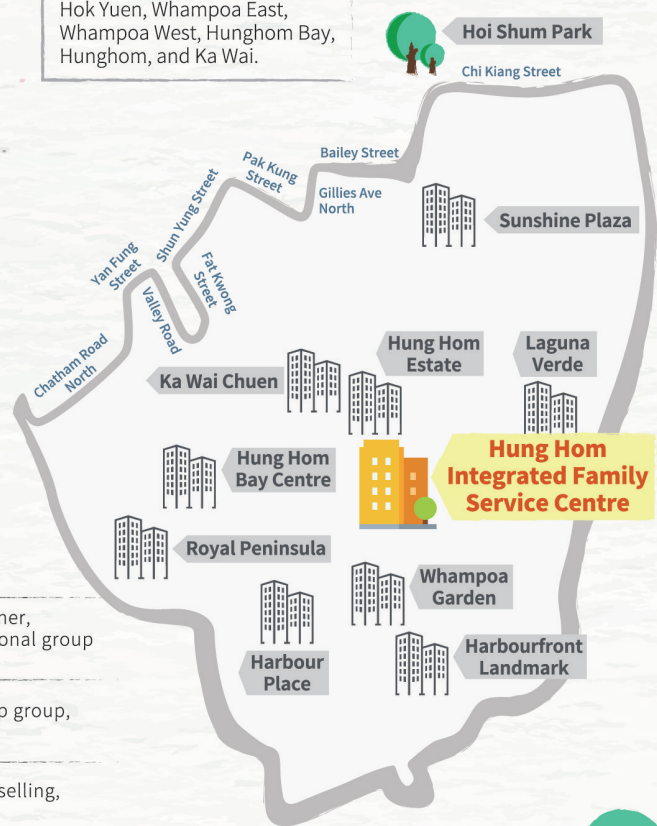


Purpose and Objectives of Service

Target Group of Service

Individual and families residing within the service boundary of Hok Yuen, Whampoa East, Whampoa West, Hunghom Bay, Hunghom, and Ka Wai.



Service Principles

- Accessibility**: Providing one-stop localized centre services to foster accessibility and convenience for the families in need.
- Early Identification**: By the initiative to contact, outreach strategies, wide publicity and use of the assessment tools, to identify individuals and families in need as soon as possible.
- Service Integration**: Integrate family service and other services to provide more comprehensive and high-quality services for the families.
- Partnership**: Partnership with community organizations through outreaching and networking in order to use and access the resources more efficiently for the family.

Procedures of Application and Withdrawal

Service user or his/her family members, relatives or friends can approach our center either through letter, phone call or drop-in to apply for our service. Other helping professions or referrers are welcome to refer users for our follow up service through phone contact or written referral. If service user intends to withdraw from our service, he/she can make such request to his/her respective social worker for service arrangement.
