

Target Group

1. For Children under six with disabilities / special needs and are attending the KGs/ KG-cum-CCCs participating in OPRS who are:
(A) On-site Pre-school Rehabilitation Services

Upon receiving assessment by paediatricians, clinical/ educational psychologists or other qualified professionals as recognized by SWD, referrals can be made by social workers of medical social services units, integrated family service centres, family and child protective services units, adoption unit or designated service units to Central Referral System for Rehabilitation Services – Subsystem for Disabled Pre-schoolers (CRSRehab-PS) for application for pre-school rehabilitation services.

(B) OPRS Waitee Services

Services will be provided to applicants registered and wait-listing for OPRS under CRSRehab-PS.

(C) Tier 1 Support Services

Awaiting assessment by Child Assessment Centres (CACs), or ; Assessed by CACs to have borderline developmental problem, or Assessed by our professionals of centre as having special needs with reference to the “Child Observation Checklist” (COC).

Charges of Service

Procedures For Exiting Service

Service users can make a request to the responsible worker if he/she intends to withdraw from our services or activities. The request will be handled on an individual basis.

Purpose & Objective

1. To provide early identification and intervention, training and support to children assessed with disabilities and special needs;
2. To provide training and support for teachers / child care workers on knowledge and skills in working with children with disabilities and special needs;
3. To provide support for parents / carers on positive attitude and effective skills in nurturing their children with special needs.

Service Content

Our inter-disciplinary service team provide the following services under a school-based and integrated approach:

- ★ **For Children with different levels of disabilities / special needs**
Screening/ assessment for children;
On-site individual/group training and support;
Class-based observation/assessment and support;
Centre-based training.
- ★ **For teacher and child care workers**
Professional consultation/ talks/workshops/ seminars, class-based support/ assessment/ demonstration and case review conferences.
- ★ **For teacher child care workers**
Support/ consultation/ training/ talks/ workshops/ seminars on knowledge and skills in nurturing children with disabilities/ special needs.

Procedures for Application

- (A) On-site Pre-school Rehabilitation Services**
Referrals can be made by social workers or staff of rehabilitation service units to the Central Referral System for Rehabilitation Services of the Social Welfare Department (SWD).
- (B) OPRS Waitee Services**
Information of applicant will be passed to our centre via CRSRehab-PS. Our worker will contact the applicants directly for arrangement of services. The applicant does not need to apply separately.
- (C) Tier 1 Support Services**
Parents may consult the teachers or other professions of participating KGs or approach our centre for enquiries or application.
