Hong Kong Children & Youth Services is a multi-social service agency. The Agency provides social services including Integrated Family Services, Clinical Psychological Service, Community Care Services for the Elderly, Small Group Homes, Foster Care Service, Integrated Children & Youth Services Centre. After-School Care Service, Children and Youth Centre, School Social Work and Support Services, District Youth Outreaching Social Work Service, Overnight Outreaching Service, Counselling Centre for Psychotropic Substance Abusers, Cyber Youth Support Service, Children and Parents Services, Children's Rehabilitation Services and other Special Projects.

Service Delivery

Provide Stationing Service at Pre-primary Institutions:

Including casework service, professional consultation service and developmental / supportive / therapeutic groups and programmes, including children emotional and social development group, parent-child activities, parents support, professional development for personnel for child protection, etc. Introduce community resources and multi-disciplinary professional support service.

Parent Education and Support Service for parents

- Talks, workshops and activities are organized to develop positive parenting skills, stress management etc. to strengthen family functions.
- Consultation services, counselling and referral services are rendered to parents and family in need.


