

Procedures of Application and withdrawal

Casework Service

Students and their parents can apply for counseling service in person, by telephone or through referrals from schools and other professionals.

Groups and Programmes

Groups and programmes will be publicized at schools or promoted through teachers. Enrollment can be directed to School Social Workers or the school authority.

Consultation Service

Students, parents and teachers can approach School Social Workers for guidance on health, schooling, career, developmental adjustment, family, peer relationship, community service and etc.

Withdrawal Method

Withdrawal request from casework service, groups and programmes can be forwarded to the responsible School Social Worker for further arrangement.

School Social Workers render free casework and consultation services. Charges for groups and programmes vary in accordance with its nature. Participants with financial difficulties can apply for remission.

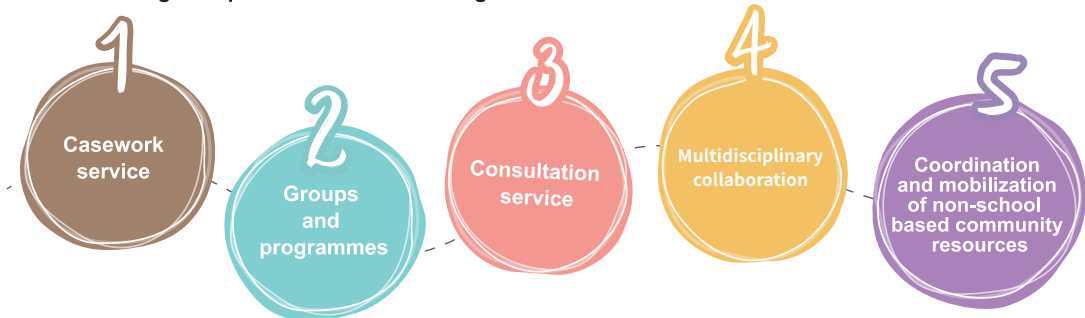
Target Group of Service
